

DO YOU WANT TO CHANGE YOUR **NAME** OR **GENDER MARKER**?

Are you trans, non-binary or genderqueer?

You can **change your gender marker and first or middle name** by sending an application to Quebec's registrar of civil status (the Directeur de l'état civil).

EXAMPLES OF ID THAT CAN BE CHANGED:

- you and your child's acts of birth
- your act of marriage or civil union
- your health insurance card
- your driver's license
- your passport

THINGS TO KNOW BEFORE APPLYING:

You must usually have lived
in Quebec for at least 1 year.

You don't need gender-affirming care
to legally change your gender marker!
